

If you are home isolating or off for any other reason and you are well enough to do your school work, here is what you need to do:

## REMOTE LEARNING GUIDE - Reception

### Step 1:

Log into Tapestry and go to the 'Activities' tab.

Here you will find the timetable for the week which will give you an overview of the learning.



### Step 2:

Each morning, you will find a zoom link within your 'observations' tab. The zoom call will be live from 8:45 so that your child can join in with the morning activity. The activity will be explained in the comments section of zoom each day.

At 9:00 we will sing the hello song together and the teacher will explain the activities for the day.



### Step 3:

You can then start doing the activities that have been set for your child by checking the timetable and following the instructions.

If you have any questions, the zoom link will be live until 10am. To ask a question, click the zoom link again where you will join the waiting room. The teacher will then admit you to the call when they are free. Alternatively, you can leave a message on Tapestry by adding a comment or privately through creating a new observation. A member of staff in your child's year group will try and get back to you as soon as possible.



### Step 4:

Throughout the day, a member of staff in your child's year group might call you again to support with anything that you are stuck with. A staff member in your child's year group will be in contact to arrange a time for extra video calls.



### Step 5:

You can then start doing the afternoon's work that has been set for your child by checking the timetable and following the instructions.



### Step 6:

At the end of the day, we will join together again via zoom for a story read by a member of the reception team. You will find the zoom link within your 'observations' tab. Your child will need to be in the call at 3pm to take part in this activity.

If you are stuck, the answers to these questions might help you solve the problem:

### What do I do if I lose my password for Tapestry?

Please contact your class teacher for support logging into Tapestry.

### How do I log in to Tapestry?

To use Tapestry for remote learning and to access the activities you need to log in via a web browser.

### How does my child complete the work?

Each activity will vary and you can choose how you want to communicate the completed activity with us by uploading pictures and videos or adding notes to Tapestry. Some activities will not require evidence to be uploaded.

### Do we have to do the work?

Yes. You are expected to show your Bowerham Best, whether you are working at home or at school. This means you must work hard wherever you are.

### Do we have to follow the timetable?

The timetable is there as a guide. We do advise that you complete two phonics sessions each day as well as your magical maths activity. The activities should take 10 – 15 minutes and the day should be broken up with lots of learning through play. Please see the provision timetables for provision ideas.
