RE: remote learning key information (year 1 – 6)

Expectations

If your child is ill, they should take time to rest and recover as they would in normal circumstances. If your child is at home due to isolation or school closures and is well, it is essential that your child is accessing Showbie daily and completing the work that has been set for them, to ensure children continue to have access to effective learning and continue their learning journey with as little impact as possible.

Timetable

Each week, your child's class teacher will post a timetable on Showbie. This will outline lessons for the week, set a time for it to be completed and give a brief overview of the lesson. Your child can then access the resources they will need to complete the lessons, that have been outlined on the timetable, in the purple subject folders on Showbie. The children can then complete their work online using the tools on Showbie or on paper and upload an image to Showbie to then receive feedback as either written comments or voice notes.

Video calls

A member of staff in your child's year group will be in contact daily with your child whilst they are working from home.

- 1) Each morning a member of staff in your child's year group will host a video chat for all children to outline the learning for the day. The time for this video chat will be published on the weekly timetable.
- 2) Throughout the day, a member of staff in your child's year group may also schedule additional calls to offer support and deliver lessons live. This may be as a whole class call or within a smaller set of children. A member of staff in your child's year group will be in touch to arrange additional video calls where necessary.
- 3) At the end of the school day, a member of staff in your child's year group will host a video chat for all children to answer any questions and read the class book. The time for this video chat will be published on the weekly timetable.

Feedback

A member of staff in your child's year group will leave feedback on Showbie on work that has been uploaded. If your child needs support with the work they are completing throughout the day, they can leave a message on Showbie. A member of staff in your child's year group will respond as soon as possible and may leave written or verbal feedback or organise an additional video call.
